Friday 25<sup>th</sup> September: Practice Day 08.00 am till 5.00pm (Targets will then be set for start of comp)

Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> September: Rifle Lever Action Silhouette (80 shots).

Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> September: Pistol Cartridge Lever Action Silhouette (80 shots).

Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September: Rim fire Lever Action Silhouette (80 shots).

Sight in time on match days will be 7.00am – 8.15am, Morning brief 8.45am then first shot at 9.00am

All matches will be shot in accordance with the current Rifle Metallic Silhouette rulebook.

Nominations will be \$ 25.00 per 80 shot match. 3 gun will be \$60.00. Juniors free.

**Payments accepted on the day as long as nomination was in first, no nominations will be accepted on the day.**

**Nominations to be received no later than Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2020**

Local range rules apply, whilst uncased and not in use, **ALL firearms will have actions open.**

Starting time on Match days will be 9.00am, pre nominations are **mandatory** to assist with catering.

**All competitors are expected to help in some way with the running of the competition.**

Medals will be awarded in all grades, trophies for two-gun, three gun and juniors.

# Lever Action Silhouette WA State Team Selection Criteria

1. The Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette WA state team selection will be based on the Annual SSAA WA State Championship results.
2. Selection will be based on the top ten placing's in the Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette Annual State Championship of the aggregate score of all three match categories of Rifle Cartridge, Pistol Cartridge and Rimfire Cartridge.
3. The Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette WA state team will consist of up to four adult members and attending juniors.
4. The adult team members will be selected from the competitors with the highest ranking aggregate score from the annual Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette State Championships that have nominated for the WA state team selection.
5. The junior team members will be selected from the juniors that attend the annual Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette State Championships that have nominated for the WA state team selection.
6. Its expected a competitor should as a minimum achieve a top ten placing to achieve membership of the Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette WA state team. The junior member will not be expected only encouraged to achieve a top ten placing.
7. Only Annual State Championships may be used as a selection shoot.
8. There is no guarantee that a SSAA Team will qualify for yearly funding.
9. All SSAA WA Teams are subject to the SSAA WA State Executive approval and discipline funding.
10. It's a competitor's responsibility to notify the State Delegate if they wish to be considered for selection for any team as soon as possible.
11. In some circumstances due to timing the previous year's State Championship results may be used to determine selection of a team however this requires SSAA WA State Executive approval.
12. The selection process should be completed by the relevant Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette Discipline Delegate as soon as possible after their Annual State Championship and submitted to the SSAA WA State executive for approval
